# Extended

The following is an update from our Missionary,  
Jeff David in Costa Rica:

"Several weeks ago I went to the emergency  
room with severe chest pains. The attending  
emergency room doctors ran all the tests to see  
if I was having a heart attack. The results of the  
ECG and ultrasound were negative, but the blood  
test returned with traces of the enzyme that the  
heart releases when it lacks sufficient oxygen,  
which usually happens during a heart attack. I  
was admitted to the hospital, and the cardiolo-  
gist ordered an angiogram to take a peek at my  
arteries. There is some blockage there, but not  
enough to merit a stent or any other invasive  
procedure."

"However, the iodine-based dye that was  
pumped into my veins for the angiogram pro-  
voked a virulent allergic reaction and I had to  
spend three more days of "vacation" in the hos-  
pital. After all the tests and probing, the conclu-  
sion is that I'm part of a small percent of the  
population who has heart spasms. The condition  
is easily treated with meds, but it can provoke or  
be a precursor to a full-blown attack. So I'm be-  
ing obedient to doctor's orders and taking my  
meds."
